

## **Stained Glass Courses - Fall 2022**

### **15 Hour Beginner Stained Glass**

Session 1: Wednesdays, September 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> AND 28<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm  
Session 2: Saturdays, October 15<sup>th</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup> AND 29<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm

The 15Hour Beginner Stained Glass course is designed for people who have little or no experience working with stained glass. Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer that pattern to glass, cut and grind stained glass, apply copper foil, solder and "finish" their piece. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher and an 8" X 10" hanging stained glass panel. **COST: \$235**

### **Mini Beginner Stained Glass**

Session 3: Wednesday, October 19<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm  
Session 4: Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm

This course is offered as a one day introduction to stained glass and is designed for individuals with little or no experience working with glass. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher. **COST: \$110**

### **Introduction to Glass Fusing**

Session 5: Saturday, September 17<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 2 pm  
Session 6: Friday, October 28<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 2 pm  
Session 7: Wednesday, November 9<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 2 pm

This course introduces participants to the basics of fusing glass in a kiln. Students will create a 6" by 6" fused glass tile which may be hung as a suncatcher or, for those experienced in stained glass, incorporated into a stained glass panel. **COST: \$85**

### **Intermediate Glass Fusing**

Session 8: Tuesday, November 22<sup>nd</sup> 11 am – 2 pm

This course is offered as an extension of the "Introduction to Glass Fusing" course; whereby students will be given an opportunity to create a larger project such as fused bowl or plate. Projects typically involve a 2-step firing process. Material costs average \$25 - \$35 for this class. **COST: \$45 + materials**

### **"Glass on Glass" Mosaic Window**

Session 9: Fridays, October 7<sup>th</sup> AND 14<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a stained glass mosaic on a salvaged window provided by the student. Please note that the total area of exposed glass in the window should NOT EXCEED 3 square feet. A variety of pattern ideas and glass will be made available; as well as other necessary materials and supplies such as stained glass, adhesive and grout. If you wish to "finish" your window frame (i.e., sand, stain or paint), it is advised that this be done prior to the start of the class. **COST: \$165**

### **Fused Glass Windchime**

Session 10: Thursday, September 22<sup>nd</sup> 11 am – 4 pm

A variety of fusing glass will be available and students will be encouraged to use their creativity to create a unique and one-of-a-kind fused glass windchime that can be hung indoors or out. Glass cutting experience is helpful; but not entirely necessary. **COST: \$125**

### **Panel Lamp (Intermediate)**

Session 11: Thursdays, November 17<sup>th</sup> AND 24<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm

This class is aimed at students with basic stained glass experience. A selection of patterns will be made available prior to the start of the class. Students are required to purchase their own glass and other required materials such as copper foil and solder. **COST: \$75 + materials**

### **Fused Glass Coasters**

Session 12: Thursday, September 15<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 2 pm

Session 13: Tuesday, November 8<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 2 pm

Session 14: Wednesday, December 7<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 2 pm

Come and create a set of four (4) original glass coasters that are unique and functional! No previous glass experience is necessary. The course fee includes four pre-cut 4" by 4" clear glass coaster "bases", a large selection of colourful fusing stained glass, kiln firing of your coasters and rubber "bumpers" for the underside of your lovely coasters. **COST: \$75**

### **Bevelled and Stained Glass Snowflake**

Session 15: Thursday, October 13<sup>th</sup> 10 am – 4 pm

Session 16: Wednesday, November 16<sup>th</sup> 10 am – 4 pm

Create a lovely snowflake using bevelled glass and your choice of stained glass and globs. Basic previous experience with cutting and foiling stained glass is recommended. All materials are included with the course fee.

**COST: \$110**

### **Fused Glass Holiday Ornaments**

Session 17: Wednesday, October 5<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 2 pm

Session 18: Saturday, November 19<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 2 pm

Session 19: Thursday, December 8<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 2 pm

Students will create four unique fused glass holiday ornaments. All materials to make four ornaments are included with the course fee; as well as kiln firing. **COST: \$75**

**Fused Picture in Glass**

Session 20: Saturday, September 24<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm  
Session 21: Saturday, November 12<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm

Create a unique “framed” fused glass wall hanging. Students will be provided with a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles” to incorporate into a panel which will be kiln fired and mounted on a picture frame. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing. **COST: \$145**

**Funky Stained Glass Candleholder**

Session 22: Thursday, September 29<sup>th</sup> 10 am – 4 pm  
Session 23: Thursday, October 20<sup>th</sup> 10 am – 4 pm

Come and spend a relaxing day creating a lovely stained glass candleholder. **Participants must have prior experience cutting, foiling and soldering stained glass.** The course fee includes stained glass, glass globs, copper foil and solder required to complete your project. **COST: \$110**

**Fused Candle/Light Vase**

Session 24: Wednesday, October 26<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm  
Session 25: Tuesday, November 15<sup>th</sup> 11 am – 4 pm

Create four (4) fused glass panels that will be attached to a 4-sided clear glass “vase” which can be lit up using either a candle or a string of LED lights. Students will be provided with a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles” to create 4 panels which will be fired in a kiln and then mounted on a clear glass vase. The course fee includes all materials required to create 4 panels, clear glass vase and kiln firing. **COST: \$145**
