

Stained Glass Courses - Spring 2020

Beginner Stained Glass 5 Weeks - 15 Hours Total

Session 1: Wednesdays, April 1 st – 29 th	6 – 9 pm
Session 2: Thursdays, April 16 th – May 14 th	12:30 – 3:30 pm
Session 3: Fridays, May 22 nd – June 19 th	6 – 9 pm

The Beginner Stained Glass course is designed for people who have little or no experience working with stained glass. Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer that pattern to glass, cut and grind stained glass, apply copper foil, solder and "finish" their piece. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher and an 8" X 10" hanging stained glass panel. **COST: \$195**

Mini Beginner Stained Glass

Session 4: Saturday, April 18 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 5: Monday, May 11 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 6: Wednesday, June 17 th	11 am – 4 pm

This course is offered as a one-day introduction to stained glass and is designed for individuals with little or no experience working with glass. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher. **COST: \$75**

Introduction to Glass Fusing

Session 7: Tuesday, April 14 th	11 am – 2 pm
Session 8: Saturday, May 30 th	11 am – 2 pm
Session 9: Wednesday, June 24 th	11 am – 2 pm

This course introduces participants to the basics of fusing glass in a kiln. Students will create a 6" by 6" fused glass tile which may be hung as a suncatcher or, for those experienced stained glass, incorporated into a stained glass panel. **COST: \$60**

Intermediate Glass Fusing

Session 10: Friday, May 8 th	11 am – 2 pm
Session 11: Tuesday, June 30 th	11 am – 2 pm

This course is offered as an extension of the "Introduction to Glass Fusing" course; whereby students will be given an opportunity to create a larger project such as fused bowl or plate. Projects typically involve a 2-step firing process. Material costs average \$25 - \$35 for this class. **COST: \$45 + materials**

"Glass on Glass" Mosaic Window

Session 12: Friday, April 17 th AND 24 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 13: Saturdays, May 16 th AND 23 rd	11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a stained glass mosaic on a salvaged window provided by the student. Please note that the total area of exposed glass in the window should NOT EXCEED 3 square feet. A variety of pattern ideas and glass will be made available; as well as other necessary materials and supplies such as stained glass, adhesive and grout. If you wish to "finish" your window frame (i.e., sand, stain or paint), it is advised that this be done prior to the start of the class. **COST: \$145**

Mosaic Stepping Stone

Session 14: Saturday, April 25 th	10 am – 5 pm
Session 15: Thursday, May 21 st	10 am – 5 pm
Session 16: Saturday, June 27 th	10 am – 5 pm

Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer a pattern to glass, cut & grind stained glass, prepare a stepping stone mold, mix and pour cement and how to “finish” their stone. Students will be provided with materials, patterns, use of tools and instruction to complete one 14” round or 16” hexagonal stepping stone.

COST: \$105

Mosaic Table Top

Session 17: Mondays, April 20 th AND 27 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 18: Saturdays, June 6 th AND 13 th	11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a beautiful 19” round mosaic table top using stained glass and/or glass mosaic tiles. The course fee includes a metal table base and clear glass top, stained glass, tiles, adhesive and grout. A selection of design ideas will also be made available.

COST: \$155

Panel Lamp (Intermediate)

Session 19: Saturday, May 2 nd AND 9 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 20: Tuesday, June 16 th AND 23 rd	11 am – 4 pm

This class is aimed at students with basic stained glass experience. A selection of patterns will be made available prior to the start of the class. Students are required to purchase their own glass and other required materials such as copper foil and solder.

COST: \$75 + materials

Copper Foil Stained Glass Panel (Intermediate)

Session 21: Wednesday, May 20 th AND 27 th	11 am – 4 pm

This is a course for individuals who have worked in the copper foil technique and are looking for guidance with respect to constructing a larger panel. Twelve (12) hours of instruction are included; as well as the use of hand tools, grinders and studio space. “Consumable” materials required to complete the panel (e.g. glass, copper foil, solder, flux, metal came for edging, etc.) are NOT included in the course fee. Students must be able to “pack in and pack out” their projects each session; as storage space is limited. If instruction and studio time beyond the 12 hours included in the course are needed; additional time may be purchased at \$10/hour.

COST: \$120 + materials

Fused Glass Windchime

Session 22: Saturday, April 11 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 23: Tuesday, May 26 th	11 am – 4 pm

A variety of fusing glass will be available and students will be encouraged to use their creativity to create a unique and one-of-a-kind fused glass windchime that can be hung indoors or out. Glass cutting experience is helpful; but not entirely necessary.

COST: \$85

Fused Glass Coasters

Session 24: Tuesday, May 5th 11 am – 2 pm
Session 25: Wednesday, June 10th 6 – 9 pm

Come and create a set of four (4) original glass coasters that are unique and functional! No previous glass experience is necessary. The course fee includes four pre-cut 4" X 4" clear glass coaster "bases", a large selection of colourful fusing glass, kiln firing of your coasters and rubber "bumpers" for the underside of your lovely coasters.

COST: \$65**Stained Glass Box (Intermediate)**

Session 26: Wednesday, May 6th 10:30 am – 5 pm
Session 27: Thursday, June 11th 10:30 am – 5 pm

This class is suitable for students with basic stained glass experience. Students will cut out and construct a stained glass box using stained glass, mirror, bevels and hinges. All materials required to construct the box are included.

COST: \$85**Basic Jewellery**

Session 28: Monday, June 29th 11 am – 3 pm

This class focuses on turning stained glass into unique, one-of-a-kind jewellery. Students will learn how to wire wrap a glass cabochon, copper foil and solder a pendant, grind a groove and drill glass pieces for pendants and earrings. Students will be provided with a selection of stained and fused glass and all materials required to create 3 to 4 pendants and 1 pair of earrings.

COST: \$65**Garden Ornaments**

Session 29: Monday, May 4th 11 am – 4 pm
Session 30: Thursday, June 18th 11 am – 4 pm

Students will construct whimsical garden creatures such as dragonflies and butterflies using a combination of stained glass, wire and beads. All materials to make two ornaments are included with the course fee.

COST: \$65**Fused Glass Panel Lantern**

Session 31: Saturday, April 4th 11 am – 4 pm
Session 32: Tuesday, May 12th 11 am – 4 pm
Session 33: Saturday, June 20th 11 am – 4 pm

Create a beautiful 4-sided lantern that can be hung up or placed on a table. Students will be provided with clear fusing glass panels cut to fit each side of a metal lantern along with a variety of colourful fusing glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and "pebbles". The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

COST: \$125
