

Stained Glass Courses - Spring 2025

15 Hour Beginner Stained Glass

Session 1: Wednesdays, April 2 nd , 9 th & 16 th	11 am - 4 pm
Session 2: Saturdays, May 3 rd , 10 th & 17 th	11 am - 4 pm
Session 3: Fridays, June 6 th , 13 th & 20 th	11 am - 4 pm

The Beginner Stained Glass course is designed for people who have little or no experience working with stained glass. Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer that pattern to glass, cut and grind stained glass, apply copper foil, solder and "finish" their piece. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher and an 8" X 10" hanging stained glass panel. **COST: \$245**

Mini Beginner Stained Glass

Session 4: Saturday, April 12 th	11 am - 4 pm
Session 5: Wednesday, May 7 th	11 am - 4 pm
Session 6: Thursday, June 26 th	11 am - 4 pm

This course is offered as a one-day introduction to stained glass and is designed for individuals with little or no experience working with glass. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher. **COST: \$120**

Introduction to Glass Fusing

Session 7: Friday, April 4 th	11 am - 1 pm
Session 8: Wednesday, May 14 th	11 am - 1 pm
Session 9: Thursday, June 19 th	11 am - 1 pm

This course introduces participants to the basics of fusing glass in a kiln. Students will create a 6" by 6" fused glass tile which may be hung as a suncatcher or, for those experienced stained glass, incorporated into a stained glass panel. **COST: \$85**

Intermediate Glass Fusing

Session 10: Wednesday, May 14 th	2 - 5 pm

This course is offered as an extension of the "Introduction to Glass Fusing" course; whereby students will be given an opportunity to create a larger project such as fused bowl or plate. Projects typically involve a 2-step firing process. Material costs average \$35 - \$45 for this class. **COST: \$45 + materials**

“Glass on Glass” Mosaic Window

Session 11: Thursdays, April 3rd & 10th 11 am – 4 pm
Session 12: Wednesdays, June 18th & 25th 11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a stained glass mosaic on a salvaged window provided by the student. Please note that the total area of exposed glass in the window should NOT EXCEED 3 square feet. A variety of pattern ideas and glass will be made available; as well as other necessary materials and supplies such as stained glass, adhesive and grout. If you wish to "finish" your window frame (i.e., sand, stain or paint), it is advised that this be done prior to the start of the class. **COST: \$165**

Panel Lamp (Intermediate)

Session 13: Fridays, April 11th AND 25th 11 am – 4 pm
Session 14: Saturdays, June 14th AND 28th 11 am – 4 pm

This class is aimed at students with basic stained glass experience. A selection of patterns will be made available prior to the start of the class. Students are required to purchase their own glass and other required materials such as copper foil and solder. **COST: \$95 + materials**

Garden Ornaments

Session 15: Thursday, April 17th 11 am – 4 pm
Session 16: Wednesday, May 21st 11 am – 4 pm

Students will construct whimsical garden creatures such as dragonflies and butterflies using a combination of stained glass, wire and beads. All materials to make two ornaments are included with the course fee.

COST: \$95

Fused and Stained Glass Hanging Panel

Session 17: Thursdays, May 15th AND 22nd 11 am – 4 pm

During the first class, you will create a 6" X 8" fused glass panel. During the second class, you will select and cut a combination of stained glass and bevels to frame out your fused panel using copper foil stained glass techniques. Previous experience cutting and soldering stained glass is required. The course fee includes fusing glass, kiln firing, bevelled glass, stained glass, solder and came required to complete your project. **COST: \$145**

Fused Glass Windchime

Session 18: Friday, May 9th 11 am – 4 pm

A variety of fusing glass will be available and students will be encouraged to use their creativity to create a unique and one-of-a-kind fused glass windchime that can be hung indoors or out. Glass cutting experience is helpful; but not entirely necessary. **COST: \$125**

Dragonfly Garden Spinner (Intermediate)

Session 19: Wednesday, April 23rd 11 am – 4 pm
Session 20: Thursday, June 12th 11 am – 4 pm

So many people love dragonflies – they happily flit around the garden with their beautiful iridescent wings; not bothering a soul. Spend a few hours creating your own stained glass dragonfly suspended within a brass hoop. Your creation will be suspended using a “spinner” so that when hung indoors or out, it will move with the breeze and spin to catch the light. All materials are included with the course fee. **COST: \$125**

Mosaic Stepping Stone

Session 21: Saturday, April 26th 10 am – 5 pm
Session 22: Saturday, June 7th 10 am – 5 pm

Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer a pattern to glass, cut & grind stained glass, prepare a stepping stone mold, mix and pour cement and how to “finish” their stone. Students will be provided with materials, patterns, use of tools and instruction to complete one 14” round or 16” hexagonal stepping stone. **COST: \$145**

Fused Glass Garden Lantern

Session 23: Saturday, May 31st 11 am – 4 pm
Session 24: Saturday, June 21st 11 am – 4 pm

Create a beautiful 4-sided lantern that can be hung up or placed on a table. Students will be provided with clear fusing glass panels cut to fit each side of a metal lantern along with a variety of colourful fusing glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles”. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing. **COST: \$145**
