

## **Stained Glass Courses – Spring 2026**

### **15 Hour Beginner Stained Glass**

Session 1: Saturdays, May 2, 9 & 16 11 am – 4 pm  
Session 2: Thursdays, June 4, 11 & 18 11 am – 4 pm

The Beginner Stained Glass course is designed for people who have little or no experience working with stained glass. Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer that pattern to glass, cut and grind stained glass, apply copper foil, solder and "finish" their piece. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher and an 8" X 10" hanging stained glass panel. **COST: \$249**

### **Mini Beginner Stained Glass**

Session 3: Saturday, April 11 11 am – 4 pm  
Session 4: Wednesday, April 22 11 am – 4 pm  
Session 5: Friday, May 22 11 am – 4 pm  
Session 6: Saturday, June 20 11 am – 4 pm

This course is offered as a one-day introduction to stained glass and is designed for individuals with little or no experience working with glass. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher. **COST: \$125**

### **Introduction to Glass Fusing**

Session 7: Friday, April 24 11 am – 1 pm  
Session 8: Wednesday, May 20 11 am – 1 pm

This course introduces participants to the basics of fusing glass in a kiln. Students will create a 6" by 6" fused glass tile which may be hung as a suncatcher or, for those experienced stained glass, incorporated into a stained glass panel. **COST: \$95**

### **Intermediate Glass Fusing**

Session 9: Wednesday, May 20 2 – 5 pm

This course is offered as an extension of the "Introduction to Glass Fusing" course; whereby students will be given an opportunity to create a larger project such as fused bowl or plate. Projects typically involve a 2-step firing process. Material costs average \$35 - \$45 for this class. **COST: \$55 + materials**

### **"Glass on Glass" Mosaic Window**

Session 10: Thursdays, May 21 & 28 11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a stained glass mosaic on a salvaged window provided by the student. Please note that the total area of exposed glass in the window should NOT EXCEED 3 square feet. A variety of pattern ideas and glass will be made available; as well as other necessary materials and supplies such as stained glass, adhesive and grout. If you wish to "finish" your window frame (i.e., sand, stain or paint), it is advised that this be done prior to the start of the class. **COST: \$175**

**Bevelled and Stained Glass Snowflake** (Intermediate)

Session 11: Friday, March 27

11 am – 5pm

Create a lovely snowflake using bevelled glass and your choice of stained glass and globs. Basic previous experience with cutting and foiling stained glass is recommended. All materials are included with the course fee.

**COST: \$125****Mosaic Stepping Stone**

Session 12: Wednesday, May 27

10 am – 5 pm

Session 13: Saturday, June 13

10 am – 5 pm

Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer a pattern to glass, cut & grind stained glass, prepare a stepping stone mold, mix and pour cement and how to “finish” their stone. Students will be provided with materials, patterns, use of tools and instruction to complete one 14” round or 16” hexagonal stepping stone.

**COST: \$175****Garden Ornaments**

Session 14: Wednesday, April 15

11 am – 4 pm

Session 15: Thursday, May 14

11 am – 4 pm

Session 16: Saturday, June 27

11 am – 4 pm

Students will construct whimsical garden creatures such as dragonflies and butterflies using a combination of stained glass, wire and beads. All materials to make two ornaments are included with the course fee.

**COST: \$105****Fused and Slumped Candleholders**

Session 17: Friday, April 24

2 – 5 pm

Students will create a set of one-of-a-kind fused glass candleholders. Participants will be provided with an assortment of colourful fusing glass, stringers, noodles, frits, etc. to design and create their own unique pieces of glass that will be fired twice: first to “fuse” their creation and secondly to “slump” their glass over a mold to shape it into a candleholder (or vase)!

**COST: \$110****Dragonfly Garden Spinner** (Intermediate)

Session 18: Thursday, April 9

11 am – 4 pm

Session 19: Wednesday, June 10

11 am – 4 pm

So many people love dragonflies – they happily flit around the garden with their beautiful iridescent wings; not bothering a soul. Spend a few hours creating your own stained glass dragonfly suspended within a brass hoop. Your creation will be suspended using a “spinner” so that when hung indoors or out, it will move with the breeze and spin to catch the light. All materials are included with the course fee.

**COST: \$125****Fused Picture in Glass**

Session 20: Saturday, April 25

11 am – 4 pm

Session 21: Friday, May 29

11 am – 4 pm

Create a unique “framed” fused glass wall hanging. Students will be provided with a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles” to incorporate into a panel which will be kiln fired and mounted on a picture frame. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

**COST: \$145**

**Fused Glass Garden Lantern**

Session 22: Thursday, April 30

11 am – 4 pm

Session 23: Friday, June 5

11 am – 4 pm

Create a beautiful 4-sided lantern that can be hung up or placed on a table. Students will be provided with clear fusing glass panels cut to fit each side of a metal lantern along with a variety of colourful fusing glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles”. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

**COST: \$145****3D Stained Glass Spinner** (Intermediate)

Session 24: Wednesday, April 8

11 am – 4 pm

Session 25: Wednesday, May 13

11 am – 4 pm

Session 26: Saturday, June 6

11 am – 4 pm

This class is for students with basic stained glass copper foil experience. Students will be provided with a pattern as well as a selection of stained glass and all materials required to complete a lovely multi-sided spinner.

**COST: \$175****Fused Glass Plant Pokes**

Session 27: Wednesday, April 29

11 am – 2 pm

Session 28: Saturday, May 23

11 am – 2 pm

Session 29: Friday, June 19

11 am – 2 pm

Have fun creating four (4) fused glass plant pokes using a wide variety of stained glass, noodles, stringers and other fusing components.

**COST: \$95****Fused Glass Garden Stake**

Session 30: Friday, May 8

11 am – 4 pm

Session 31: Wednesday, June 24

11 am – 4 pm

Create a unique garden accent by combining a fused glass disc (created by you) and displayed in a metal garden stake. All glass and embellishments, as well as the firing of the glass in a kiln and 3 foot tall metal garden stake are included in the course fee.
