

Stained Glass Courses – Summer & Fall 2025

15 Hour Beginner Stained Glass

Session 1: Wednesdays, July 16, 23 & 30	11 am – 4 pm
Session 2: Thursdays, September 11, 18 & 25	11 am – 4 pm
Session 3: Saturdays, October 18, 25 & November 1	11 am – 4 pm
Session 4: Wednesdays, November 12, 19 & 26	11 am – 4 pm

The Beginner Stained Glass course is designed for people who have little or no experience working with stained glass. Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer that pattern to glass, cut and grind stained glass, apply copper foil, solder and "finish" their piece. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher and an 8" X 10" hanging stained glass panel.

Mini Beginner Stained Glass

This course is offered as a one-day introduction to stained glass and is designed for individuals with little or no experience working with glass. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher.

COST: \$120

Introduction to Glass Fusing

Session 11: Wednesday, September 24	11 am – 1 pm
Session 12: Thursday, October 16	11 am – 1 pm
Session 13: Saturday, November 8	11 am – 1 pm
Session 14: Friday, December 5	11 am – 1 pm

This course introduces participants to the basics of fusing glass in a kiln. Students will create a 6" by 6" fused glass tile which may be hung as a suncatcher or, for those experienced stained glass, incorporated into a stained glass panel.

COST: \$85

Intermediate Glass Fusing

Session 15: Friday, October 24	1 – 4 pm
Session 16: Thursday, November 13	1 – 4 pm

This course is offered as an extension of the "Introduction to Glass Fusing" course; whereby students will be given an opportunity to create a larger project such as fused bowl or plate. Projects typically involve a 2-step firing process. Material costs average \$35 - \$45 for this class.

COST: \$45 + materials

“Glass on Glass” Mosaic Window

Session 17: Thursdays, July 17 & 24	11 am – 4 pm
Session 18: Fridays, August 15 & 22	11 am – 4 pm
Session 19: Wednesdays, September 10 & 17	11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a stained glass mosaic on a salvaged window provided by the student. Please note that the total area of exposed glass in the window should NOT EXCEED 3 square feet. A variety of pattern ideas and glass will be made available; as well as other necessary materials and supplies such as stained glass, adhesive and grout. If you wish to "finish" your window frame (i.e., sand, stain or paint), it is advised that this be done prior to the start of the class.

COST: \$165

Copper Foil Stained Glass Panel (Intermediate)

Session 20: Thursdays, July 31 & August 7	11 am – 4 pm
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This is a course for individuals who have worked in the copper foil technique and are looking for guidance with respect to constructing a larger panel. Twelve (12) hours of instruction are included; as well as the use of hand tools, grinders and studio space. “Consumable” materials required to complete the panel (e.g. glass, copper foil, solder, flux, metal came for edging, etc.) are NOT included in the course fee. Students must be able to “pack in and pack out” their projects each session; as storage space is limited. If instruction and studio time beyond the 12 hours included in the course are needed; additional time may be purchased at \$10/hour.

COST: \$125 + materials

Bevelled and Stained Glass Snowflake (Intermediate)

Session 21: Thursday, September 4	11 am – 5pm
Session 22: Wednesday, October 15	11 am – 5pm
Session 23: Saturday, November 22	11 am – 5 pm

Create a lovely snowflake using bevelled glass and your choice of stained glass and globs. Basic previous experience with cutting and foiling stained glass is recommended. All materials are included with the course fee.

COST: \$120

Leaded Stained Glass (Intermediate)

Session 24: Wednesday, November 5	10 am – 5 pm
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This is a course for individuals experienced in working with stained glass. Students will construct a stained glass panel using lead came, bevels and stained glass.

COST: \$165

Fused Glass Holiday Ornaments

Session 25:	Saturday, October 18	11 am – 2 pm
Session 26:	Wednesday, October 22	11 am – 2 pm
Session 27:	Friday, November 7	11 am – 2 pm
Session 28:	Saturday, November 29	11 am – 2 pm
Session 29:	Wednesday, December 10	11 am – 2 pm

Students will create four unique fused glass holiday ornaments. All materials to make four ornaments are included with the course fee; as well as kiln firing. **COST: \$75**

Fused Dichroic Glass Pendant

Session 30:	Wednesday, December 3	11 am – 1 pm
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Create beautiful fused glass pendants accented with eye-catching dichroic glass. This course includes glass and materials to create two lovely pendants using dichroic glass. In addition, students may create another two pendants without dichroic. Four silver or gold-plated bails are also included for hanging your pendants.

COST: \$65

Fused Glass Coasters

Session 31:	Saturday, December 6	11 am – 2 pm
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Come and create a set of four (4) original glass coasters that are unique and functional! No previous glass experience is necessary. The course fee includes four pre-cut 4" X 4" clear glass coaster "bases", a large selection of colourful fusing glass, kiln firing of your coasters and rubber "bumpers" for the underside of your lovely coasters.

COST: \$85

Funky Stained Glass Candleholder (Intermediate)

Session 32:	Thursday, November 20	11 am – 4 pm
Session 33:	Thursday, December 11	11 am – 4 pm

Come and spend a relaxing day creating a lovely stained glass candleholder. ***Participants must have prior experience cutting, foiling and soldering stained glass.*** The course fee includes stained glass, glass globes, copper foil and solder required to complete your project. **COST: \$125**

Fused Picture in Glass

Session 34:	Friday, November 21	11 am – 4 pm
Session 35:	Saturday, December 13	11 am – 4 pm

Create a unique "framed" fused glass wall hanging. Students will be provided with a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and "pebbles" to incorporate into a panel which will be kiln fired and mounted on a picture frame. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing. **COST: \$145**

Fused Glass Garden Lantern

Session 36: Thursday, October 9

11 am – 4 pm

Session 37: Friday, November 28

11 am – 4 pm

Create a beautiful 4-sided lantern that can be hung up or placed on a table. Students will be provided with clear fusing glass panels cut to fit each side of a metal lantern along with a variety of colourful fusing glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles”. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

COST: \$145
