

Stained Glass Courses – Summer & Fall 2026

15 Hour Beginner Stained Glass

Session 1: Wednesdays, July 15, 22 & 29	11 am – 4 pm
Session 2: Thursdays, September 10, 17 & 24	11 am – 4 pm
Session 3: Fridays, October 16, 23 & 30	11 am – 4 pm

The Beginner Stained Glass course is designed for people who have little or no experience working with stained glass. Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer that pattern to glass, cut and grind stained glass, apply copper foil, solder and "finish" their piece. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher and an 8" X 10" hanging stained glass panel.

Mini Beginner Stained Glass

Session 4: Saturday, July 18	11 am – 4 pm
Session 5: Wednesday, August 19	11 am – 4 pm
Session 6: Wednesday, September 16	11 am – 4 pm
Session 7: Saturday, October 17	11 am – 4 pm
Session 8: Wednesday, November 18	11 am – 4 pm
Session 9: Friday, December 11	11 am – 4 pm

This course is offered as a one-day introduction to stained glass and is designed for individuals with little or no experience working with glass. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher.

COST: \$125

Introduction to Glass Fusing

Session 10: Thursday, October 8	11 am – 1 pm
Session 11: Saturday, November 7	11 am – 1 pm

This course introduces participants to the basics of fusing glass in a kiln. Students will create a 6" by 6" fused glass tile which may be hung as a suncatcher or, for those experienced stained glass, incorporated into a stained glass panel.

COST: \$95

Intermediate Glass Fusing

Session 12: Friday, November 13	1 – 4 pm

This course is offered as an extension of the "Introduction to Glass Fusing" course; whereby students will be given an opportunity to create a larger project such as fused bowl or plate. Projects typically involve a 2-step firing process. Material costs average \$35 - \$45 for this class.

COST: \$55 + materials

“Glass on Glass” Mosaic Window

Session 13: Fridays, July 24 & 31	11 am – 4 pm
Session 14: Fridays, August 21 & 28	11 am – 4 pm
Session 15: Wednesdays, October 7 & 14	11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a stained glass mosaic on a salvaged window provided by the student. Please note that the total area of exposed glass in the window should NOT EXCEED 3 square feet. A variety of pattern ideas and glass will be made available; as well as other necessary materials and supplies such as stained glass, adhesive and grout. If you wish to "finish" your window frame (i.e., sand, stain or paint), it is advised that this be done prior to the start of the class.

Bevelled and Stained Glass Snowflake (Intermediate)

Session 16: Wednesday, November 4	11 am – 4 pm
Session 17: Friday, November 27	11 am – 4 pm
Session 18: Saturday, December 5	11 am – 4 pm

Create a lovely snowflake using bevelled glass and your choice of stained glass and globs. Basic previous experience with cutting and foiling stained glass is recommended. All materials are included with the course fee.

COST: \$145

Fused Picture in Glass

Session 19: Friday, October 9	11 am – 4 pm
Session 20: Wednesday, November 25	11 am – 4 pm

Create a unique “framed” fused glass wall hanging. Students will be provided with a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles” to incorporate into a panel which will be kiln fired and mounted on a picture frame. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

COST: \$145

Fused Glass Lantern

Session 21: Wednesday, October 21	11 am – 4 pm
Session 22: Saturday, November 21	11 am – 4 pm

Create a beautiful 4-sided lantern that can be hung up or placed on a table. Students will be provided with clear fusing glass panels cut to fit each side of a metal lantern along with a variety of colourful fusing glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles”. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

COST: \$145

Fused Glass Plant Pokes

Session 23: Wednesday, October 28	11 am – 2 pm
Session 24: Friday, November 20	11 am – 2 pm

Have fun creating four (4) fused glass plant pokes using a wide variety of stained glass, noodles, stringers and other fusing components.

COST: \$95

Fused Glass Holiday Ornaments

Session 25: Saturday, November 14	11 am – 2 pm
Session 26: Thursday, November 26	11 am – 2 pm
Session 27: Wednesday, December 9	11 am – 2 pm

Students will create four unique fused glass holiday ornaments. All materials to make four ornaments are included with the course fee; as well as kiln firing. **COST: \$95**

Fused Dichroic Glass Pendant

Session 28: Thursday, November 5	11 am – 1 pm
Session 29: Saturday, December 12	11 am – 1 pm

Create beautiful fused glass pendants accented with eye-catching dichroic glass. This course includes glass and materials to create two lovely pendants using dichroic glass. In addition, students may create another two pendants without dichroic. Four silver or gold-plated bails are also included for hanging your pendants.

COST: \$65

3D Stained Glass Spinner (Intermediate)

Session 30: Thursday, August 6	11 am – 4 pm
Session 31: Wednesday, September 23	11 am – 4 pm
Session 32: Saturday, October 31	11 am – 4 pm

This class is for students with basic stained glass copper foil experience. Students will be provided with a pattern as well as a selection of stained glass and all materials required to complete a lovely multi-sided spinner. **COST: \$175**
