

Stained Glass Courses - Winter 2023

15 Hour Beginner Stained Glass

Session 1: Saturdays, January 14 th , 21 st AND 28 th	11 am - 4 pm
Session 2: Wednesdays, January 25 th , February 1 st AND 8 th	11 am - 4 pm
Session 3: Thursdays, March 2 nd , 9 th AND 16 th	11 am - 4 pm

The 15 Hour Beginner Stained Glass class is designed for people who have little or no experience working with stained glass. Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer that pattern to glass, cut and grind stained glass, apply copper foil, solder and "finish" their piece. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher and an 8" X 10" hanging stained glass panel. **COST: \$235**

Mini Beginner Stained Glass

Session 4: Tuesday, January 17 th	11 am - 4 pm
Session 5: Saturday, February 11 th	11 am - 4 pm
Session 6: Wednesday, March 15 th	11 am - 4 pm

This course is offered as a one-day introduction to stained glass and is designed for individuals with little or no experience working with glass. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher. **COST: \$110**

Introduction to Glass Fusing

Session 7: Thursday, January 12 th	11 am - 2 pm
Session 8: Saturday, February 4 th	11 am - 2 pm
Session 9: Tuesday, March 7 th	11 am - 2 pm

This course introduces participants to the basics of fusing glass in a kiln. Students will create a 6" by 6" fused glass tile which may be hung as a suncatcher or, for those experienced in working with stained glass, incorporated into a stained glass panel. **COST: \$85**

Intermediate Glass Fusing

Session 10: Saturday, February 18 th	11 am - 4 pm
Session 11: Tuesday, March 14 th	11 am - 4 pm

This course is offered as an extension of the "Introduction to Glass Fusing" course; whereby students will be given an opportunity to create a larger project such as fused bowl or plate. Projects typically involve a 2-step firing process. Material costs average \$35 - \$45 for this class. **COST: \$45 + materials**

"Glass on Glass" Mosaic Window

Session 12: Thursday, February 2 nd AND 9 th	11 am - 4 pm

Students will create a stained glass mosaic on a salvaged window provided by the student. Please note that the total area of exposed glass in the window should NOT EXCEED 3 square feet. A variety of pattern ideas and glass will be made available; as well as other necessary materials and supplies such as stained glass, adhesive and grout. If you wish to "finish" your window frame (i.e., sand, stain or paint), it is advised that this be done prior to the start of the class. **COST: \$165**

Fused Picture in Glass

Session 13: Wednesday, January 18th 11 am – 4 pm
Session 14: Saturday, February 25th 11 am – 4 pm

Create a unique “framed” fused glass wall hanging. Students will be provided with a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles” to incorporate into a panel which will be kiln fired and mounted on a picture frame. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing. **COST: \$145**

Leaded Stained Glass (Intermediate)

Session 15: Wednesday, February 15th 10 am – 5 pm

This is a course for individuals experienced in working with stained glass. Students will construct a stained glass panel using lead came, bevels and stained glass. **COST: \$155**

Bevelled and Stained Glass Snowflake

Session 16: Thursday, January 26th 10 am – 5 pm
Session 17: Wednesday, February 22nd 10 am – 5 pm

Create a lovely snowflake using bevelled glass and your choice of stained glass and globs. Basic previous experience with cutting and foiling stained glass is recommended. All materials are included with the course fee. **COST: \$110**

Panel Lamp (Intermediate)

Session 18: Friday, February 17th AND 24th 11 am – 4 pm

This class is aimed at students with basic stained glass experience. A selection of patterns will be made available prior to the start of the class. Students are required to purchase their own glass and other required materials such as copper foil and solder. **COST: \$75 + materials**

Fused Glass Coasters

Session 19: Wednesday, January 11th 11 am – 2 pm

Come and create a set of four (4) original glass coasters that are unique and functional! No previous glass experience is necessary. The course fee includes four pre-cut 4” X 4” clear glass coaster “bases”, a large selection of colourful fusing glass, kiln firing of your coasters and rubber “bumpers” for the underside of your lovely coasters. **COST: \$75**

Funky Stained Glass Candleholder

Session 20: Wednesday, March 1st 10 am – 4 pm
Session 21: Saturday, March 25th 10 am – 4 pm

Come and spend a relaxing day creating a lovely stained glass candleholder. **Participants must have prior experience cutting, foiling and soldering stained glass.** The course fee includes stained glass, glass globs, copper foil and solder required to complete your project. **COST: \$110**

Fused Dichroic Glass Pendant

Session 22: Saturday, March 11th

1 – 3 pm

Create beautiful fused glass pendants accented with eye-catching dichroic glass. This course includes glass and materials to create two lovely pendants using dichroic glass. In addition, students may create another two pendants without dichroic. Four silver or gold-plated bails are also included for hanging your pendants.

COST: \$65
