

Stained Glass Courses - Fall 2019

Beginner Stained Glass 5 Weeks - 15 Hours Total

Session 1: Wednesdays, September 18 th – October 16 th	6 – 9 pm
Session 2: Thursdays, October 3 rd – 31 st	12:30 – 3:30 pm
Session 3: Fridays, November 1 st – 29 th	6 – 9 pm

The Beginner Stained Glass course is designed for people who have little or no experience working with stained glass. Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer that pattern to glass, cut and grind stained glass, apply copper foil, solder and "finish" their piece. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher and an 8" X 10" hanging stained glass panel. **COST: \$185**

Mini Beginner Stained Glass

Session 4: Saturday, September 21 st	11 am – 4 pm
Session 5: Tuesday, October 8 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 6: Thursday, November 14 th	11 am – 4 pm

This course is offered as a one day introduction to stained glass and is designed for individuals with little or no experience working with glass. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher. **COST: \$65**

Introduction to Glass Fusing

Session 7: Saturday, September 14 th	11 am – 2 pm
Session 8: Tuesday, October 15 th	11 am – 2 pm
Session 9: Saturday, November 9 th	11 am – 2 pm

This course introduces participants to the basics of fusing glass in a kiln. Students will create a 6" by 6" fused glass tile which may be hung as a suncatcher or, for those experienced in stained glass, incorporated into a stained glass panel. **COST: \$55**

Intermediate Glass Fusing

Session 10: Saturday, September 28 th	11 am – 2 pm
Session 11: Tuesday, November 12 th	11 am – 2 pm

This course is offered as an extension of the "Introduction to Glass Fusing" course; whereby students will be given an opportunity to create a larger project such as fused bowl or plate. Projects typically involve a 2-step firing process. Material costs average \$25 - \$35 for this class. **COST: \$40 + materials**

"Glass on Glass" Mosaic Window

Session 12: Fridays, September 20 th AND 27 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 13: Saturdays, October 5 th AND 12 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 14: Mondays, November 18 th AND 25 th	11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a stained glass mosaic on a salvaged window provided by the student. Please note that the total area of exposed glass in the window should NOT EXCEED 3 square feet. A variety of pattern ideas and glass will be made available; as well as other necessary materials and supplies such as stained glass, adhesive and grout. If you wish to "finish" your window frame (i.e., sand, stain or paint), it is advised that this be done prior to the start of the class. **COST: \$135**

Fused Glass WindchimeSession 15: Tuesday, September 24th 11 am – 4 pm

A variety of fusing glass will be available and students will be encouraged to use their creativity to create a unique and one-of-a-kind fused glass windchime that can be hung indoors or out. Glass cutting experience is helpful; but not entirely necessary.

COST: \$75**Dragonfly Garden Spinner** (Intermediate)Session 16: Monday, October 7th 11 am – 4 pm

So many people love dragonflies – they happily flit around the garden with their beautiful iridescent wings; not bothering a soul. Spend a few hours creating your own stained glass dragonfly suspended within a brass hoop. Your creation will be suspended using a “spinner” so that when hung indoors or out, it will move with the breeze and spin to catch the light. All materials are included with the course fee.

COST: \$65**Mosaic Stepping Stone**Session 17: Monday, September 16th 10 am – 5 pm

Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer a pattern to glass, cut & grind stained glass, prepare a stepping stone mold, mix and pour cement and how to “finish” their stone. Students will be provided with materials, patterns, use of tools and instruction to complete one 14” round or 16” hexagonal stepping stone.

COST: \$99**Basic Jewellery**Session 18: Monday, October 21st 11 am – 3 pm

This class focuses on turning stained glass into unique, one-of-a-kind jewellery. Students will learn how to wire wrap a glass cabochon, copper foil and solder a pendant, grind a groove and drill glass pieces for pendants and earrings. Students will be provided with a selection of stained and fused glass and all materials required to create 3 to 4 pendants and 1 pair of earrings.

COST: \$59**Mosaic Table Top**Session 19: Fridays, October 4th AND 11th 11 am – 4 pmSession 20: Saturdays, November 16th AND 23rd 11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a beautiful 19” round mosaic table top using stained glass and/or glass mosaic tiles. The course fee includes a metal table base and clear glass top, stained glass, tiles, adhesive and grout. A selection of pattern ideas will also be made available.

COST: \$145

Fused Panel LanternSession 21: Saturday, November 2nd

11 am – 4 pm

Create a beautiful 4-sided lantern that can be hung up or placed on a table. Students will be provided with clear fusing glass panels cut to fit each side of a metal lantern plus a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles”. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

COST: \$125**Copper Foil Stained Glass Panel**Session 22: Wednesday, October 23rd AND 30th

11 am – 4 pm

This is a course for individuals who have worked in the copper foil technique and are looking for guidance with respect to constructing a larger panel. Twelve (12) hours of instruction are included; as well as the use of hand tools, grinders and studio space. “Consumable” materials required to complete the panel (e.g. glass, copper foil, solder, flux, metal came for edging, etc.) are NOT included in the course fee. Students must be able to “pack in and pack out” their projects each session; as storage space is limited. If instruction and studio time beyond the 12 hours included in the course are needed; additional time may be purchased at \$10/hour.

COST: \$120 + materials**Fused Picture in Glass**Session 23: Thursday, December 5th

11 am – 4 pm

Create a unique “framed” fused glass wall hanging! Students will be provided with a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles” to incorporate into a panel which will be kiln fired and mounted on a picture frame. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

COST: \$125**Panel Lamp (Intermediate)**Session 24: Wednesdays, November 6th AND 13th

11 am – 4 pm

This class is aimed at students with basic stained glass experience. A selection of patterns will be made available prior to the start of the class. Students are required to purchase their own glass and other required materials such as copper foil and solder.

COST: \$75 + materials**Fused Glass Coasters**Session 25: Monday, December 2nd

11 am – 2 pm

Come and create a set of four (4) original glass coasters that are unique and functional! No previous glass experience is necessary. The course fee includes four pre-cut 4” by 4” clear glass coaster “bases”, a large selection of colourful fusing stained glass, kiln firing of your coasters and rubber “bumpers” for the underside of your lovely coasters.

COST: \$65**Stained Glass Box**Session 26: Saturday, October 19th

10:30 am – 5 pm

Session 27: Thursday, November 21st

10:30 am – 5 pm

Students will cut out and construct a stained glass box using stained glass, mirror, bevels and hinges. All materials required to construct the box are included.

COST: \$75

Bevelled and Stained Glass Snowflake

Session 28: Friday, October 18th 11 am – 4 pm
Session 29: Saturday, November 30th 11 am – 4 pm

Create a lovely snowflake using bevelled glass and your choice of stained glass and globs. Basic previous experience with cutting and foiling stained glass is recommended. All materials are included with the course fee.

COST: \$75

Fused Glass Holiday Ornaments

Session 30: Tuesday, October 29th 11 am – 2 pm
Session 31: Wednesday, November 20th 6 – 9 pm
Session 32: Saturday, December 7th 11 am – 2 pm

Students will create four unique fused glass holiday ornaments. All materials to make four ornaments are included with the course fee; as well as kiln firing.

COST: \$65
