

Stained Glass Courses – Summer & Fall 2024

15 Hour Beginner Stained Glass

Session 1: Thursdays, July 4 th , 11 th AND 18 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 2: Wednesdays, August 14 th , 21 st AND 28 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 3: Thursdays, September 19 th , 26 th AND October 3 rd	11 am – 4 pm
Session 4: Fridays, October 11 th , 18 th AND 25 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 5: Saturdays, November 9 th , 16 th AND 23 rd	11 am – 4 pm

The 15 Hour Beginner Stained Glass course is designed for people who have little or no experience working with stained glass. Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer that pattern to glass, cut and grind stained glass, apply copper foil, solder and "finish" their piece. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher and an 8" X 10" hanging stained glass panel. **COST: \$245**

This course is offered as a one day introduction to stained glass and is designed for individuals with little or no experience working with glass. Students will be provided with materials, use of tools and instruction to complete a suncatcher. **COST: \$120**

This course introduces participants to the basics of fusing glass in a kiln. Students will create a 6" by 6" fused glass tile which may be hung as a suncatcher or, for those experienced in stained glass, incorporated into a stained glass panel. **COST: \$85**

"Glass on Glass" Mosaic Window

Session 17: Saturdays, July 20 th AND 27 th	11 am – 4 pm
Session 18: Wednesdays, September 11 th And 18 th	11 am – 4 pm

Students will create a stained glass mosaic on a salvaged window provided by the student. Please note that the total area of exposed glass in the window should NOT EXCEED 3 square feet. A variety of pattern ideas and glass will be made available; as well as other necessary materials and supplies such as stained glass, adhesive and grout. If you wish to "finish" your window frame (i.e., sand, stain or paint), it is advised that this be done prior to the start of the class. **COST: \$165**

Mosaic Stepping Stone

Session 19: Friday, July 19th 10 am – 5 pm

Students will learn how to prepare a pattern, transfer a pattern to glass, cut & grind stained glass, prepare a stepping stone mold, mix and pour cement and how to “finish” their stone. Students will be provided with materials, patterns, use of tools and instruction to complete one 14” round or 16” hexagonal stepping stone.

COST: \$145

Garden Ornaments

Session 20: Wednesday, July 17th 11 am – 4 pm

Students will construct whimsical garden creatures such as dragonflies and butterflies using a combination of stained glass, wire and beads. All materials to make two ornaments are included with the course fee.

COST: \$95

Fused Glass Garden Lantern

Session 21: Wednesday, July 24th 11 am – 4 pm

Create a beautiful 4-sided lantern that can be hung up or placed on a table. Students will be provided with clear fusing glass panels cut to fit each side of a metal lantern along with a variety of colourful fusing glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles”. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

COST: \$145

Bevelled and Stained Glass Snowflake

Session 27: Wednesday, October 9th 10 am – 5 pm

Session 28: Wednesday, November 13th 10 am – 5 pm

Session 29: Friday, December 6th 10 am – 5 pm

Create a lovely snowflake using bevelled glass and your choice of stained glass and globs. Basic previous experience with cutting and foiling stained glass is recommended. All materials are included with the course fee.

COST: \$120

Fused Picture in Glass

Session 30: Thursday, October 17th 11 am – 4 pm

Session 31: Thursday, November 21st 11 am – 4 pm

Create a unique “framed” fused glass wall hanging. Students will be provided with a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles” to incorporate into a panel which will be kiln fired and mounted on a picture frame. The course fee includes all materials required plus kiln firing.

COST: \$145

Fused Glass Holiday Ornaments

Students will create four unique fused glass holiday ornaments. All materials to make four ornaments are included with the course fee; as well as kiln firing.

COST: \$75

Fused Candle/Light Vase

Session 39: Friday, November 1 st W	11 am – 4 pm

Create four (4) fused glass panels that will be attached to a 4-sided clear glass “vase” which can be lit up using either a candle or a string of LED lights. Students will be provided with a variety of colourful fusing stained glass, rods, stringers, noodles, frits and “pebbles” to create 4 panels which will be fired in a kiln and then mounted on a clear glass vase. The course fee includes all materials required to create 4 panels, clear glass vase and kiln firing.

COST: \$125
